VEHICLE HIGHLIGHTS

- Offered in Premium Luxury (FWD & AWD) and Sport (AWD) models, with standard 7-passenger seating or available 6-passenger, second-row captain's chair seating
- Premium Luxury models are trimmed with exotic wood decor, while the Sport features performance-inspired carbon fiber trim
- Sport models feature Continuous Damping Control (CDC) active handling and a faster steering ratio, with greater overall responsiveness
- Platinum Package is available. Content includes: Semi-Aniline leather seating for all rows; leather-wrapped instrument panel, console and door trim; microfiber sueded headliner; front and rear premium carpeted floor mats. Also includes CDC suspension on Premium Luxury
- Illuminated Cadillac Crest hands-free liftgate is standard
- Standard power-folding third-row seat and remote fold-down feature for the second-row seat; tip/pitch-and-slide feature on the second-row seat allows easy access to the third row
- Heated front-row seats are standard, with heated/ventilated front seats and heated outboard rear seats available
- Adaptive Remote Start is standard

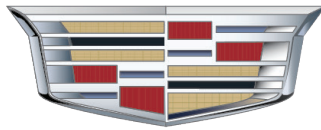
